**April** - The Downtown San Diego Partnership Clean & Safe Program is the Property and Business Improvement District (PBID) for Downtown. The geographical area our district covers is 272 blocks, which includes the following neighborhoods: Core Columbia; Cortez; East Village; the Gaslamp Quarter and Marina. Added together the five neighborhoods account for 5,330 parcels; 269,622 linear feet of street frontage; 1,657 enhanced, special benefit lighting poles; over 300 trash receptacles; 990 regular sidewalks and over 100 enhanced sidewalks.

The Clean & Safe Team of Maintenance and Safety Ambassadors are deployed in the five Downtown neighborhoods 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Our Maintenance crews perform maintenance activities in the public right of way supplementing the City of San Diego's services.
